Our visitors are trying to form a residents association to improve the provision of play facilities for young children at play area near Bearlands/Pitman Place/Hill Road. Communications have been difficult, but hoping to organise public meeting to discuss. The current equipment needs refurbishing, there are boundary and litter issues and further equipment is needed. WYLG suggested:

Visitors meet with Sue Bailey and Paul Smith and attend the next Town Council meeting Bank account could be opened through Recreational Trust

Katie could work with group to access a Barnwood Trust Small Sparks Grant

Succession planning needs careful thought

Stuart Strathearne from SDC could take on the maintenance

An annual inspection and insurance would be required

WYLG could possibly hold some ring-fenced funds

Funds will soon be available from the Recreational Trust via Jeff Walshe
