2.	Children [11 to 16 years]	one sandwich cake
3.	Children [5 to 10 years]	five fairy cup cakes
4.	Children [up to 5 years]	five fairy cup cakes

PRIZES: £1.50 for First, £1.00 for Second and £0.50 for Third place in each Class.

RUIFS:

- 1. All cakes must be home made by the person entering the cake.
- Entry forms must be brought with your cake(s) to Hilldale Village Hall on Saturday 12th May between 9:00 and 10:00 am. Please use <u>one</u> form for each entry.
- 3. You can't enter more than two entries.
- 4. Your cakes must be displayed in a clear plastic bag or container.
- 5. Entry fee: for each entry: 50p Children aged 10 and under are free.
- 6. The judges' decisions are final.
- 7. All entries must be removed between 3:00 and 4:00 pm.

Hilldale Parish Council


