

## **April 2015 Parental consent letter**

Dear Parent/Guardian

So that your child can safely attend Great Bardfield Youth Club, we need you to complete the following information and sign the form. Without a completed, signed form, your child will not be able to attend. Once signed in, during light summer evenings, members must stay within view of the pavilion and the immediate grounds between 7.00pm and 9.00pm. During the dark winter evenings when we operate from the Town Hall, they must stay inside the building. Please encourage children to return home immediately after Youth Club. Noisy behaviour in the village reflects badly on us. Please see our attached Behaviour Policy which you and your child agree to comply with by signing below.

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## **GBYC Behaviour Policy**

At GBYC we expect members to behave in a respectful and appropriate manner towards other members and Supervisors while at Youth Club. We will not tolerate continuous inappropriate or disrespectful behaviour from anyone under any circumstances. Anyone displaying such behaviour will first be given an official verbal warning by two supervisors who will clearly explain that it is an official warning and why it is being given. If the bad behaviour continues, a written warning will be sent directly to the member's parent or guardian. If the bad behaviour persists, the member will be immediately excluded from the club for up to 3 months at the club leader's discretion.

Inappropriate and disrespectful behaviour that is unacceptable includes:

- Any act of violence
- Threatening and aggressive language and behaviour both in general and directed at individuals or groups.
- Any property abuse or intentional damage (including theft and borrowing without permission of the owner)
- Swearing, both in general and at individuals (this includes name-calling and the use of derogative and discriminating language)
- Any form of bullying and harassment which includes excluding individuals or groups from activities.
- A negative, disruptive or discouraging attitude, especially when it purposely spoils the enjoyment of others.
- Smoking, bringing alcohol on to the premises during Youth Club hours
- Bringing any items in to, or around the premises which are considered dangerous including knives, matches, fireworks etc

This list is not exhaustive and we retain the right to exclude anyone who continues to display bad behaviour while at the club. It is also understood that occasional outbursts, whilst inappropriate, might not be regarded as continuous bad behaviour in which case a warning might not be regarded as serious as described above.
