Wheatcroft all my Land in Wexington in the Parish of Shroton and
County of Dorset for her Life and at the Death of Mary Wheatcroft
I do Give all my Land unto my son John Wheatcroft and to his
Carors for Ever In witness whereof I do Give unto my son John Wheatcroft
all my Goods and Chattels paying all my Debts and Duties
and I do bequeath and Make my son John Wheatcroft full and sole
Executor of this my Last will and Testament hereby Revoaking
Revoking and Making void all former wills in which hereunto
I have set my hand and seal the Day and year above Written
