You may be aware that the Community Council, with the support of Staffordshire County Council, has been involved over the past 12 months in a project seeking to address the issue of isolation and loneliness, often experienced by elderly, disabled or vulnerable people. This is a pilot project helping 6 local communities scattered around the county to set up their own Good Neighbour Schemes.

We are now trying to establish how many other communities in Staffordshire would like to set up similar schemes in their area and would be pleased to hear whether this is something that would be of interest to you.

The current schemes are funded until August 2014 and we do not currently have any commitments from funders after this date, but if a substantial number of communities express a desire to have a scheme in their area, this may help us to secure the necessary resources to set up new schemes.

## **Staffordshire Good Neighbour Schemes**

Good Neighbour Schemes provide support for the elderly, disabled, or anyone who feels isolated within their community. The principle of the scheme is that local volunteers offer a service in their community for those in need of help and support; this can include assistance with transport, gardening or running general errands.

Good neighbourly activities take place all the time, but more and more it is found that the people who provide this support are elderly themselves and are under a strain for the ever increasing demand. A Good Neighbour Scheme seeks to spread the load and help relieve the strain on these people by attracting and supporting new volunteers to help provide the support needed in their local community.

Over the past 12 months, the Community Council has been working on a pilot project helping 6 communities to set up Good Neighbour Schemes and is now keen to find out which other communities in Staffordshire would be interested in setting up such a scheme.
