Boynes Meadows and Coppice, Brotheridge Green (SO 830 410)

Wednesday 12th June, 2 pm – 4 pm approx. Weather dry to start, cloudy, then rain.

Probably due to the wet summer and autumn last year, and cold late winter and early spring this year, the grass in the meadows was much longer and more lush, even swamping some of the flowers, compared with on our visit last year. Also, the flowering season is obviously later this year. Only the north meadow was surveyed due to the rain, but a quick look confirmed that the flowers were mostly present in the SSSI meadow also.
