Join in with her friends, as they might then pick on her.

Join in with her friends, but say sorry to Jane later.

Refuse to join in, and play with Jane instead.

Go to find and tell a teacher.

Pick it up and keep it, as no-one saw her.

Pick it up and take it home, to ask her mum what she should do.

Hand it in to the local police station, or a nearby shop.

Look in the purse to see if there is an address for the owner.

Agree: there's no-one around, and it does look fun.

Look to see why it is fenced off- there might be hidden dangers.

Say no, but agree to stay and be a look-out for the others.

Suggest that they do something else instead.

Let her brother watch his programme every time.

Let her brother watch, but mess about during the programme to spoil it for him.

Suggest that they take turns in watching their programme each week.

Ask her mum to record her programme and watch it later.
