

Dear Elmsett parents/carers and staff,

Thank you for your support throughout 2013/14 and at this years PTA AGM. At this meeting, we reported on the achievements of Elmsett PTA over the last year, elected our new committee mebers and announced our initial plans for this school year.

For those of you who weren't able to join us, here is a quick summary of the headlines:

1. Achievements

Over the last year, Elmsett PTA raised a whopping £6762. After expenses, we had £4608 of profit.

The major components of this profit were:
