A	<b>Traffic calming, speed reduction &amp; other highway / traffic management:</b> Includes Reduce speed / reduce limit to 30 mphs. Speed camera . Traffic noise / Quiet tarmac. Clear designation of entrance to village i.e. so you know you're in a built up area. Traffic calming measures. Narrow the road. Road surface quality. Road markings / Double white lines. Speed limit sign appears above St Nicholas sign but not above Bonvilston sign. Make it safe for my children to play out – traffic speed/volume. Cap vlume of existing traffic. H	<b>Footpath maintenance &amp; improvement</b> incl: Improve maintenance of footpaths / pavements. Widen the pavements (including along A48) as currently unsafe. Some re-surfacing needed e.g. from Church to Reading Room on south side. <b>TBC – Ask Gill if this relates to footpaths or road.</b> Hedgerows cut back and pavements cleared x 4. Including over grown pavements from village shop westward. Pavements along A48 to be repaired and cleared of overhanging hedges and mud.	<i>To monitor and liaise with other agencies the maintenance of footpaths/pavements.</i>				
I	<b>Community engagement &amp; communication with residents</b> Incl: Better / 2 way communication. Capture emails. Bonvilston Website – email me! Bonvilston Intranet. Newsletter – include activities (if open to the public) e.g. classes/groups and expressions of interest in starting these. With range of contributors. Village Community Association. What plans are there to welcome the new residents?	<i>To consult with residents to ascertain the need for better communication of events and local news within the village</i>				
B	<b>Pedestrian crossing on A48 between Village Shop &amp; Reading Rooms</b>	<i>To liaise with other agencies to examine the need and , if appropriate, the introduction of a pedestrian crossing.</i>				
Q	<b>Play area provisions for children</b> incl: Children's play area in Maes y Ffynnon. Planned play area inappropriate location adjacent to A48. Move the proposed play area from the A48 to Maes-Y-Ffynnon as safer & more appropriate. Play area needs someone to arrange things.	<i>To create or utilise a sports / play area as suggested</i>				
G	<b>Parking issues</b> including in Maes-y-Ffynnon & on A48 by village shop. Lorries, cars, tractors etc, on pavements rendering them impassable. Stop parking issues escalate	<i>To liaise with the Police, Vale of Glamorgan Council and other agencies to ensure that problems connected to parking are resolved.</i>				
O	<b>Playing field (suitable for child and adult activities)</b>	<i>To create or utilise a sports / play area as suggested</i>				
C	<b>Bus stops</b> including people parking in the Old Forge entrance to drop off and pick up children	<i>To liaise with bus companies and other agencies to examine the need and , if appropriate, the introduction of measures to deal with the issues raised.</i>				
P	<b>Village Cleanliness</b> incl: more bins in village. Regular litter picks. Drain at Old Forge never cleaned.	<i>To liaise with the Vale of Glamorgan Council and other agencies to ensure that problems connected with litter are resolved.</i>				
V	<b>Improvements to public transport:</b> Better, cheaper transport links (Greenways?)	<i>To liaise with bus companies and other agencies to examine the need and , if appropriate, the introduction of measures to deal with the issues raised.</i>

R	<b>Future development / New housing</b> Incl: Slow down / stop development / over development.
