[3] THE MINUTES of the previous meeting of 9th January 2016 which had been circulated were confirmed and signed. **Prop KW Sec JG**

[4] MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES. The Chairman confirmed that the joint advert for the Adoption of the new Code of Conduct had appeared in the Cowbridge GEM on Thursday 19th Jan. The cost was shared between 9 other councils at a cost of £56.40 each. Confirmed that the Electoral Roll notice is posted in the notice boards, not the Roll itself. The Clerk Vacancy has re-advertised in the Cowbridge GEM. Waterstone Homes Development – Campbell Close, Colquhoun Close. Redrow – Cae Newydd. These names have an historical connection with the land appearing on the 1843 Tithe Map.

A Council response to an enquiry regarding the Redrow sign on Redlands land stated that the planning refusal was being appealed.

A Council response to the Estate Agents signs on the entrance to Rectory Close stated that these were not permitted and had passed the issue to Highways.
