73/14 DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

74/14 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

75/14 MATTERS ARISING

a) Old Davenport Arms – Village Centre

No further progress.

b) Footpath from the Old Davenport Arms to the Garage

Mr Gregory has spoken to the Canals and Rivers Trust, who appear to be keen to assist with this, and a site meeting will be arranged in the near future.

c) Problems on A51

b) 30MPH Signs Outside the School

It was agreed that the Head Teach of the School should be asked to write to the Parish Council to advise them that the new signage is not working and to ask if they would support the School to get a 40 mph speed limit on the lane past the School. If this was obtained and policed a 20 mph speed limit could be applied for. Mr Jones of Cheshire East said at the recent Parish Council Meeting that if the Police agreed to a 40 mph speed limit in this area he would push for it to be

c) Street Lights

Ms Greenway said that when she had reported this to Cheshire East she had been given a 28 day waiting period. If the work has not been done by this time, she will contact Cheshire East Highways again.

76/14 GOVERNMENT PLANNING PORTAL

Mr Dawson read out an extract from the Government Planning Portal website which gave details of changes to the Planning laws which include the scrapping of the community Infrastructure Levy. Planning Regulations will be more similar to Building Regulations in the way they are dealt with

in that Planning Rules will be created and will have to be followed, not like the present individual treatment of applications.
