BADMAC Model Aircraft Show Rules

The Model Aircraft Show provides an opportunity for club members to display their model(s), especially those that have been created or acquired during the winter period. The show also encompasses a number of classes which members may enter their models into, namely Scale, Sport and ARTF. There are also Best in Show and Technical Achievement awards.

General Rules

- 1. Any model may be displayed in the show and the model may be at any stage of completion.
- Models to be entered into any of the classes must appear to be capable of controlled flight. They must appear to be in a finished state. i.e. fully painted/covered; engine/motor + propeller fitted if applicable; control surfaces to be connected.

Classes

Scale

The model entered will be a scale representation of a full sized, fixed or rotary wing aircraft. The model should preferably be scratch or kit built, but a modified and/or re-covered ARTF will also be eligible. Foam ARTF models are not eligible.

Sport

The model entered can be from any era or discipline of model aviation and can be either fixed or rotary wing. The model may be scratch built, kit built, or a modified and/or re-covered ARTF. Foam ARTF models are not eligible.

ARTF

The model entered can be either fixed or rotary wing. The model can be any flying ARTF model. Enhancement to the finish and detail is encouraged.

Judging

Only club members present at the Model Show are allowed to participate in the judging. They will be presented with a Judging Sheet onto which they will indicate their preferred entry in each of the three classes. They will also indicate their preferred model for the Best in Show award. The entries will be ranked according to the quantity of votes cast. Both winner and runner-up will be commended in each of the three classes.

For the Technical Achievement award, normally only Committee Members present at the Model show, who are not entrants in any of the three classes, are allowed to participate in the judging. If this is not possible due to lack of committee members then alternative arrangements will be put in place.
