As a member of ARKENFIELD RIDING CLUB, you are expected to abide by the following junior code of practice:

- ✓ All members must ride within the school rules and respect instructors and their decisions.
- ✓ All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all other participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- ✓ Members should keep to agreed timings for training or inform their instructor if they are going to be late.
- ✓ Members must wear suitable kit – APPROVED HAT, BOOT WITH A HEEL – for riding sessions JOHDPURS, are recommended but not compulsory
- ✓ Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- ✓ Junior members are not allowed to smoke
- ✓ Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind
