



INSTRUCTIONS FOR CARERS ATTENDING WITH NEW CLIENTS

- 1) New clients require a completed application form before they may drive.
- 2) Please arrive at your allocated time (if you are late you may have to wait or miss your drive altogether and still be charged).
- 3) Clients and carers should wear sensible, warm clothing (which is rain and windproof) and sensible shoes.
- 4) A receipt will be issued for each client's donation. Correct change would be appreciated.

DIRECTIONS TO DIAL WOOD CARRIAGE DRIVING FOR THE DISABLED

Travel from Wakefield

- Take the Denby Dale Road A636, go under the M1 and past Cedar Court Hotel
- Continue straight along this road until you come to a roundabout
- Take the right turn (3rd turning) off the roundabout towards HMP New Hall
- Continue past The Black Bull Pub
- Look for the white Water Tower on the right
- Turn right just after the brow of the hill (see sign HMP New Hall). Follow our purple Dial Wood signs
- Go down hill with speed bumps on and turn left at junction.
- At the barrier, press the button and let them know that you are going to the RDA stables
- Proceed past the Prison gate and follow the wall round to the car park.
- Dial Wood stables are above the car park on the left.
