Personal, social & emotional development

Circle time discussion:

- Talk about the changes that are hapenning to the trees - compare them to how they were at Christmas
- ~ Have we changed since Christmas?
- ~ Are we taller?
- ~ Can we do new things?
- ~ Talk about new life baby animals

Physical development

- ~Mud sensory tray compost, beans, seeds, garden tools, plant pots for transferring, filling, tipping
- ~Walk / garden look at new plants growing, blossom on trees, make daisy chains
- ~ Look & find activity sheets garden birds & minibeasts
- ~Spring playdough mats -modelling, cutting, shaping

Communication and language

Circle time discussion: see PSED

New language: blossom, bulbs, roots, stem, compost, plant,

- Talk about seasonal changes what have the children observed?
- Look at some spring themed words/ picture cards and discuss
- Talk about animals being born make different animal sounds
- Share spring themed stories and songs

Focus: Spring and the Garden Term 5 Week 1 & 2

- ~Spring themed books fiction and non-fiction
- ~ Spring words and picture cards
- Matching letter sounds to spring objects: show the children a letter card, can the children find an object that matches
- ~ Tracing spring words
- Look & find activity sheets garden birds & minibeasts

- Count and sort spring items:
 flowers, sheep, plant pots
- Compare sizes of plants develop language: big / medium / little
- Grow a sunflower record growth / height
- ~ Flower planting game each child has the same number of flowers and a flower pot: take turns to roll the dice & put that number of flowers into their pot. The first player to plant all their flowers wins!

Mathematics

- Cress planting: observe change and growth
- ~ Talk about what a plant needs to grow air, water, light, warmth
- Plant a bean in a glass jar observe change: shoots, roots and growth
- Minibeast hunts in the garden

- ~ Spring themed playdough mats
- Blossom pictures using tissues paper
- Nature pictures using grass, petals, leaves, daisies
- Minibeast paint stampers
- ~ Role play picnic with dollies, teddies and friends
