



Dalry Community Development Hub *Notice of Annual General Meeting* *Wednesday 2nd March 2016*

The first public meeting of the DCDH steering group took place at Dalry Primary School on 6th May 2014. At the meeting the steering group was given a mandate by the community to work towards forming a constituted and elected hub, and it was proposed that the following actions would be addressed on behalf of the Dalry community during this setting up period.

- *Establish a Community Development Hub for the Parish of Dalry*
- *Brighten up Dalry Town Centre*
- *Resolve current issues regarding ownership and the ongoing repair and maintenance of the Lynn Glen walk and other walks in the Dalry area*
- *Meet with Community Wind Power Ltd and attempt to resolve the current impasse regarding Millour Hill community benefits, and the perceived limitations imposed by the current method of managing and allocating the community benefits derived from the Dalry Community Wind Farm (Wardlaw Wood)*
- *Brighten up Dalry Railway Station with plants/flowers*
- *Lobby NAC to ensure that Community Council Boundaries of Dalry reflect the Parish/Post Code Boundaries*
- *Work with NAC to determine if the Hub should undertake some of the actions identified in the recently published Ayrshire 21 Dalry Action Plan*

The DCDH was constituted on 6th March 2015 as a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO), and the elected trustees have continued to address and progress a number of initiatives on behalf of the Dalry Community.
