Lynn Glen – Progress report – BD/AA

Great progress is being achieved, and more than 95% of the path network restoration will be completed by the  $30^{th}$  June. This has been achieved within the budget provision DCDH secured for this part of the project: £8,000.00 – Tesco phase 1 path reconstruction £14,780.00 – LandTrust phase 2 path reconstruction

Ongoing activities with input from EAW and volunteers will complete drainage and path repair at the more remote sections and deliver the following during the months of July / August /September: £951.00 – Co-oP picnic area funding + donation of 2 picnic tables from NAC. £700.00 – NAC participatory budgeting will help fund the support of volunteer activities during July / August /September.

DCDH currently has an application to Paths for All to help fund the provision of signage at various locations round the walk. If the application for £1,500.00 is successful it is anticipated, with help and input from the Heritage subgroup, NAC, EAW, SNH and volunteers, that this phase of the project will be completed by September 2017.

Another application is currently being prepared to secure £1,000.00 funding from NAC's Town Hall Charity Fund to provide a viewing platform and bench at the Lynn Spout.

Other Dalry Walks

LandTrust recently advised DCDH that they will now consider applications for the funding of other identified works required to paths in Dalry.

Trustees were asked to consider if further initiatives could be undertaken.

It was unanimously agreed that funding for any further projects should be deferred until the completion of the Lynn Glen Walk Restoration project.
