

Survey Responses – analysis

We had responses from 20% of our mailing list

Meetings

Some of the people who responded are either based out of Swindon or hold a 'watching brief' with SEG. Most of the others felt that the meeting time was good (although traffic in Swindon was occasionally unpredictable) while one felt that varying the day occasionally might draw in other people. Work commitments precluded one person. Stretching to a 7.15 finish was suggested.

Suggested meeting topics included - broader discussion on USA and European changes and connecting with other equality groups

Mail

Response to the e-mails sent out was very positive. Some quotes - 'Happy with mails - any number'. 'Mails are enjoyed and valued'. 'Shared with friends/other groups'. 'Better to have repeats than not at all'.

Rating average - 4 out of 5

Events

Most people felt that one 'big' event per year was about right (as long as the purpose was clear) while one person would welcome more. Solidarity with other Swindon groups was seen as important.

There were several useful suggestions for event topics, to be discussed at a future meeting.

Objectives

There was general support for the 2017 objectives.

Two people felt that working closely with other Swindon groups was essential and another said we should maintain our contact(s) with local MP's and Councillors

Suggestions/comments

Further comments mentioned appreciating the solidarity and one person said they would like to be more involved but work commitments precluded that at present.
