KMcC provided figures, read by DG:

- Visitor Numbers: 4,311 for October up from 3,751 in September
- Issues: -7% in October versus -6% in September. Target is zero decline.
- Access to services: 2,968 about 100 up on the previous month

DG asked AH for an update on the library re-development plan before the meeting. No further news at this time. The next update will be provided in January when a preferred developer should be known. AH to advise the Committee when he has more information and is happy to answer any specific questions by email.
