

Are you aware that.....?

The pre-school is a registered charity

- Without regular fundraising the pre-schools would not be able to continue to run. A lot of hard work goes into events planned and therefore we ask that all parents support wherever possible and encourage family, friends and neighbours to join events as well. Our next big fundraiser is the Christmas Bingo to be held at Bradford village hall on Friday 8th December

The pre-school running is supported by a voluntary committee made up of parents and staff.

- The committee is made up of a minimum of 5 members which includes 3 officers - Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer. An AGM is held once a year in June and general committee meetings are usually held once a term (next meeting is 24/1/18). The meeting can only go ahead with not less than half the committee, including any 2 of the officers there; so we need a commitment from you to attend meetings. Without the officers the pre-school is not allowed to run, so would result in immediate closure (this has never happened at our pre-schools). The meetings are friendly, relaxed and as short as possible!!
- There is also the opportunity to do some e-learning on the Preschool Learning Alliance website which can give you some further knowledge into the running of the pre-school and the care and education of your children – all for free.

We have ongoing regular fundraising throughout the year

- Alongside our organised events we also have some ongoing regular fundraising that you could all help out with.
- We collect used ink cartridges!! There is a box by the door of both pre-schools to put them in and when the box is full we can send it off and get some money back (please check the side of the box for further details).
- We do regular bags2school collections (3 times a year) where you can put all of your old clothes, shoes, bags and cuddly toys (check out the website bags2school.com for a full list of what can be included) in a bag. When the collector comes, they weigh the bags and we get money per kilo of goods!!
- Do you shop on the internet?? Go onto Easyfundraising.org.uk and register with Bradford Pre-school, then click on the shop you want to use and easyfundraising will donate a percentage of what you spend, to us. There are hundreds of shops that you can do this through.
