## <u>Reminders</u>

As it's the beginning of a new year we would like to just send out a few reminders to everyone:

- Please ensure that your children always have a coat with them, as it gets very cold out in our playground.
- If your child is not going to be in pre-school for their session, please could you let us know asap, as we generally wait for everyone to be in before we begin our main activities (we also worry!!). A text message to the appropriate setting will suffice (Bridgerule 07879 955874, Bradford 07792 501476).
- Please ensure that your child has a healthy balance of food in their packed lunch box Savoury items (sandwich, crackers, savoury pastry, cold pasta, etc.), Dairy (cheese, yoghurt), Fresh fruit (at least one piece); and please feel free to add a treat (small bun/piece of cake, some crisps, biscuit). Please remember <u>no sweets.</u> We provide water for them to drink at all times, but if you would like them to have another drink with their lunch please send it in.
- Please try and write in your child's communication book occasionally. Making links with the child's home is an important part of our practice, and having some information to start a conversation is really useful. With the current numbers in Bridgerule, particularly in the morning sessions, it may be that we don't write in your child's book every day, but we will try and ensure that we write in it at least once a week.

## <u>Keyperson Meetings</u>

Thank you for taking the time to attend your key person meetings last term - as mentioned above, working with parents is very important to us. We hope that you are all happy with the information you saw, but if you have any further questions or comments about how we do things please let us know. We value your support.
