FUNDING THE PLAYGROUND

What you told us. . .

As many of you will be aware, Shelf and District Community Group (S&DCG) have been listening to your ideas, requests and messages about improvements in the area over the past year or so. Some of you have already been in touch with us specifically about the park or the playground.

We are now launching our fund raising efforts for what you told us was your highest priority for action, the children's playground in Shelf Hall Park.

We have submitted a few small funding bids, to start the ball rolling but we are now starting our work with Calderdale Council's Communities and Service Support to raise approximately £45,000 from a Landfill Trust. We hope that this will be enough to provide new, more age appropriate play equipment.

If we are successful in this funding application, we will need to raise approximately £6,000 as a third party contribution before the end of April 2016.

Current Bid situation

We have been successful in securing an offer of £2,847 towards some of the smaller parts of the play equipment, from Calderdale Councils Small Grants pot. We need to spend this money within a year.

We have asked ESH Trust (a regional building companies charitable Arm for a contribution)

We have asked Persimmon Homes Community Champions to match our existing funds raised of £1000.

The equipment will be for a larger spread of ages and include some tarmac graphics.


Fund raising ideas
