

DFS Weekly Tips - TERM 4

1. Use tinfoil to create your words or sums.
2. During ICT, type your spelling words in different colours, fonts, sizes and styles.
3. Put paint inside a zippy bag and trace your spelling words out on top of the sealed bag using a cotton bud.
4. Use pipe cleaners to create your spelling words or sums.
5. Mould your words or numbers using playdough or plasticine.
6. Write a spelling word using a coloured wax crayon. Write the same word again, underneath, with a white wax crayon. Use a wash of paint to check to see if you got it right.
7. Use highlighters to highlight spelling patterns or number patterns.
8. Write your spelling words using a different colour of the rainbow each time. (LSCWC)
Next, try writing each letter using a different colour.
9. Using a water bottle, squirt or spray your spelling words or numbers onto the playground.
10. Buddy up and throw a ball back and forth whilst spelling your words or counting.
11. Go outside into the playground and write your spelling words or numbers using pavement chalk.
