Travel Information The Derwent Valley Line is operated by East Midlands Trains, Journey times between Derby and Matlock is 34 minutes and between Nottingham and Matlock 1 hour and 5 minutes. Train Connections at Derby Monday to Saturday, journey time from London via Derby is typically 2 hours to Belper and 2 hours 30 minutes to Matlock. Derby has good train connections with many parts of the country, including Birmingham, Bristol, Cardiff, Leeds, Leicester, Newcastle and York.
