The Derwent Valley Line is operated by East Midlands Trains. Journey time between Derby and Matlock is 34 minutes and between Nottingham and Matlock is 1 hour and 4 minutes.

Train Connections at Derby

Monday to Saturday, journey time to/from London via Derby is typically 2 hours to Belper and 2 hours 30 minutes to Matlock. Derby has good train connections with many parts of the country including Birmingham, Bristol, Cardiff, Leeds, Leicester, Newcastle and York.
