Day Trip to Doune Castle and Dunblane on Tuesday 29th August

Departing from Heathfield Retail Park at 09.00 am prompt (Bennetts Coach)

Cost £20.00 per person including driver gratuity.

We will arrive in Doune in time for morning coffee then proceed to Doune Castle, a near-complete castle set amid lovely Stirlingshire countryside. Built as the home of Regent Albany, Scotland's uncrowned King, it was later a royal residence, a dower house for widowed queens and a Jacobite prison. It was partially restored in the 1880's. Admission £4.80 per person (concession). Free to members of Historic Scotland. You do not have to be a photographer to enjoy this trip.

Doune Castle was used as a location for filming Monty Python & the Holy Grail, Game of Thrones and more recently Outlander.

From Doune we will travel to Dunblane to visit the Cathedral, one of Scotland's finest medieval churches built in the 1200's and extensively restored in the 1800's. Admission free/donations welcome. There will be time to get some lunch and to visit other buildings of historic interest, plus the shops. Our coach will depart from Dunblane at 4.00 pm.
