- 2. POSH AFTERNOON TEA We are holding our first 'Posh Afternoon Tea' on Saturday 10th August from 3pm. Please note that this is a ticket only event.
- 3. 60 YEARS MEMORABILIA As part of our 60 years' celebrations, we would love to have as many recounts, photographs, tales, pictures etc. of the current Cole Street Building. If you have any memorabilia which you think will be of interest, please see David.
- 4. 60 YEARS CELEBRATIONS Details of planned events for our 60th Anniversary of the Church Building weekend are now on posters with further details. On Thursday 3rd October at 7:00pm, we will be returning to the Opening Ceremony Service which was held 60 years ago to the day. On The Friday evening, we are holding a 'Black Country Evening with food & entertainment. This will be a ticketed event costing £10 per person. Tickets will be available to purchase from church next week and will be available online (at a cost of £11 due to a booking fee) from Skiddle during the week. On the Saturday, we will be holding an afternoon creative party; a time to reminisce and get creative by making a 'Room in a Box'. On Sunday, our 10:30am & 6:00pm services will be led by Revd Dr Caroline Wickens celebrating the 60 years of the current building. It is shaping up to be a fantastic weekend of celebrations. We hope you can join us on the weekend.
- 5. SUMMER WORKS CCTV, Heating servicing, hedge cutting and a few other jobs have already been completed. Please be advised that there are still plenty planned maintenance works happening at Cole Street over the summer including PAT testing, new lighting fixtures, redecoration and other odd job. Random patrols are also happening around the site for added security.
- 8. ROTAS FOR THE NEW CHURCH YEAR Draft copies of the new rotas, such as the flower rota, refreshment rota, door steward etc., for the coming church year are now available to view on the stage front. Please could you check these as soon as possible and make any amendments as necessary.
