- 2. JMA The amount collected so far for the JMA appeal this year stands at £126.56. A huge well done and thankyou to our children and young people for continuing to collect money in their boxes, as well as participation in the JMA service last week. Wendy has also extended her thanks to everyone else involved in the Café Style service last week everything from the technology to the last minute volunteers on refreshments! It was very much appreciated and made for a lovely morning of celebration.
- 3. BREAKFAST MORNING Thanks to all those who joined us in fellowship yesterday as we enjoyed our first Breakfast Morning of the year. With all your support and the hard work of our volunteers, we managed to raise an on the day total of around £200 towards Church funds. Many thanks everyone.
- 4. HOLIDAY CLUB Holiday Club is running on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> February from 1:00pm to 4:00pm. All children and young people are welcome and we ask that they are accompanied by a responsible person aged over 16. There will be plenty of opportunities to be creative, have time to socialise and chat and enjoy some indoor games. The club costs £1 per person with no pre-registration required just turn up. - 5. HALF-TERM MAINTENANCE With a few of the sessions taking a break during half-term, we are seeking to get a number of maintenance jobs completed. On Wednesday, a connection to the internet is due to be installed at church by OpenReach with a view to soon being able to provide a WiFi connection around the premises. We are also going to be sealing the Main Hall floor once again to keep it in as best condition as we can.
