General Notices

- THIS COMING WEEK This week sees a return to a full programme of weekly activities and hires at Cole Street. The Toddler Group & Boys' Brigade & Girls' Association both return after taking a break for the school holidays on Wednesday. There is also a Working Party on Saturday 29th February at 10:00am to which all are welcome to come along to (tea, coffee & biscuits provided!) where we will have a focus on continuing decoration of the passageway and a thorough cleaning of areas.
- 2. CHURCH COUNCIL There is a Church Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday 25th February at 6:30pm. Minutes from the previous meeting are available on the noticeboard.
- 3. HALF-TERM MAINTENANCE This week has seen a wealth of jobs undertaken at church. A new community noticeboard has been installed in the passageway, the Tradesman's Entrance has been painted and decorated as well as having a new floor covering installed, the Main Hall floor has been sealed and polished and risk assessments, procedures and audits have been updated on the Health & Safety noticeboard. The elephant in the room (or more so the scaffold tower in the room!) has been used to replace the Main Hall lights. Although there is one fixture left to convert, the new lighting in the roof is now fully converted to LEDs resulting in the lights using around a third of the power of the old lighting; a significant saving on our energy usage. Unfortunately, the engineers were unable to install a telephone line in preparation for an internet connection due to requiring a hoist and their engineers 'not being flat roof trained'. A new date is now being arranged to have this completed. Our thanks must go to many people who have contributed their time and skills this week to complete so many jobs and keeping an ethos of working togetherness at Cole Street.
- 4. WATER HEATER The water heater in the kitchen is currently not working. A new filter has been ordered and an engineer is due to service the appliance. In the meantime, please use the kettles provided or, if you need a larger amount of water, use the urns stored in the cupboard next to the hob. Many thanks.
- 5. GATE LOCKS Please ensure, when opening external gates, that the gate locks are 'locked-on' to the open gate. If the gates are being locked by a non-key holder, the lock needs passing directly to this person for safe keeping. Please ensure that no locks are left open on the gate or left lying around the premises as these are at risk of being misplaced or removed. Many thanks, the Property team.
- 6. COMMUNITY NOTICEBOARD A new noticeboard has been installed in the passageway opposite the door to the Main Hall. This noticeboard will display information relating to the wider community and is where the donation tub for the Black Country Food Bank will now be located. The noticeboard in the Main Hall will be used for church-based notices as well as required certificates and licenses.
- 7. DOOR STEWARDS Our thanks to Rachel & Liam for welcoming us on the door during February. Martin will kindly perform this duty during March.
- 8. REFRESHMENTS Our thanks to Brian and Glenda for providing tea, coffee & refreshments during February. There is currently a vacancy for this to be provided during March. If you feel able to do perform this role for the month of March, please speak to Wendy or David.
- 9. SING A NEW SONG Firstly, thank you for your continued support with the singing group. Due to increasing numbers now attending the Boys' Brigade and Girls' Association, Sing a New Song has been asked to take place at 7.30pm in the Guild Room due to the whole premises being used until this time, instead of 7.00pm.
