## NATURE NOTE 95

A year ago, I wrote about our Spotted Flycatchers nesting. Michael Holdsworth from the Cambridge Bird Club put rings on four chicks which finally left the nest on 1<sup>st</sup> July – we actually had a watching party in the drawing room to see the last one teeter on the edge of the nest box and pluck up courage to launch itself into space. Michael later told us that he had tracked down a total of only 38 breeding pairs in the whole of Cambridgeshire. On 11<sup>th</sup> May this year, the same pair appeared again at the nest box, and now (20<sup>th</sup> June) we have five chicks again ready to fledge in a day or two. Michael came last week with two professional bird people from the British Trust for Ornithology, while we were away on holiday, to ring the chicks AND the two adults. The male has a blue metal ring on his left leg while the

female has a red metal ring on her right leg *and* a geolocator tag, which acts as a radio beacon so that its movements can be tracked. Apparently very little is known about the overwintering movements of this species but it is thought to be in the Mediterranean area or north Africa. Catching, ringing and weighing the adults in a mist net seems to cause little upset to the birds when done professionally, and there are hungry mouths to feed. A similar geolocator tag has been used on many other species and in the case of Red Phalarope, it has revealed a quite extraordinary migration pattern. They breed in the Shetlands and then in the autumn they cross over Iceland, Greenland, Canada and then fly down the west coast of America to Peru!
