

*Loddon & Clavering Hundreds*



Hundreds were around in Anglo Saxon times (pre-domesday). However the map covers the situation later than c 1300. In Domesday the detached portions of Clavering are under Henstead Hundred. By around 1334 they were considered part of Loddon, but being taxed with Clavering, probably something to do with evening out the taxable population (a lot of Clavering is marsh).
