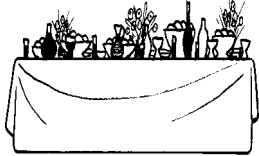
Next Sunday is a Day of Prayer for the Unemployed.

Please note: The presbytery will be empty. However phone calls to the presbytery will be redirected to Claughton, where Fr. Sony is living for the time being.

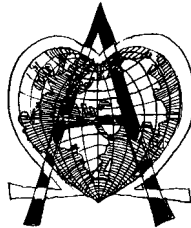
