Minutes: The Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting on 14th May 2014 had been circulated and
14/30 displayed and were taken as read, approved and signed.

Minutes: The Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council on 14th May 2014 had been
14/31 circulated and displayed and were taken as read, approved and signed.

Local Policing Report: PCSO Fiona Witcher gave an update on the current crime figures and incidents in the
14/32 Parish. There had been a second incident in which a parishioner had been bitten by a dog which was
being followed up and another theft from an outbuilding. All property holders were advised to remain
alert and aware of strange vehicles in the area. The PC thanked PCSO Witcher who then left.

Matters arising

14/33 a. Ruckhall Cagebrook Bridge. The situation was still being reported weekly and some progress
was apparent; there was still no firm date for the opening. Further damage was occurring as a result
of the bridge contractors heavy plant on the village roads and this was being reported.
b. The Code of Conduct meeting due on 10th June had been postponed due to a bereavement.
c. Cook's Charity – The PClerk had met with Humfrys & Symonds and work was in hand regarding
Cook's Charity Field.

Planning: a. The following Planning papers had been received:

14/34 i. Upper Wormhill Farm – P141366/F – Proposed change of use of agricultural building to one
dwelling
ii. Buildings at Upper Wormhill Farm – P141260/CU – Prior Approval of a proposed change of
use of agricultural building to a dwelling house (use Class C3) and for associated operational
development to form 2 dwellings and 1 holiday let accommodation
iii. Electricity Power lines – New Barns Farm to Footpath CH3 Clehonger -P141254/E

c. Application iii was for an upgrade of provision and welcomed by the PC who approved the
proposal.

b. Payment of the Insurance of the Village Hall was approved and cheque signed for £1,575.36
