MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
HELD ON 12th November 2014

Present: Mr R Christopher (Chairman), Mr A Lively, Mrs C Hanks, Mr L Wolverson and Ms A Mick
14/60 In attendance: Cllr. D Taylor, PC Wendy Powell, Linzy Outtrim (Senior Locality Steward) and 2 parishioner. Apologies for absence had been received from Mr J Johnson
Declarations of interest: Nil.
Following discussion Mr L Wolverson accepted the appointment of Vice Chairman.

Policing Report – PC Wendy Powell warned that, although the parish was not a high crime area, everyone
14/61 should be vigilant and note/report any unknown vehicles and odd behaviour in the area. Plastic wire casings found in the parish were being checked.

Minutes: The Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 8th October had been circulated and
14/62 displayed and were taken as read, approved and signed.

Model Aircraft Noise: Following complaints regarding model aircraft being flown in the parish Mr P Johnson
14/63 had been invited to the meeting to explain and discuss the situation. Mr Johnson apologised for the increased noise over the summer and an agreement was reached regarding restriction and the timings of future activity. The Chairman would formally write to Mr Johnson with the agreed details and the matter would be reviewed at the end of next summer.

Linzy Outtrim (Senior Locality Steward) was welcomed and introduced herself to the PC and outlined her
14/64 responsibilities. Her area covered the Golden Valley and, with the Chairman, she would go around the Parish but was already aware of its problems. The road from Honeymoor Common through to the Ruckhall Lane junction was scheduled for resurfacing in early December – subject to weather.

Matters arising: a. Ruckhall Cagebrook Bridge. With the fall of leaves it was important that the watercourse and
14/65 drains in the area were kept clear.
b. Neighbourhood Plan. Mr Wolverson agreed to take the lead and form a Steering Group to take the NP forward.
c. Littlemarsh Common. Longfield Services had been contracted to start work on the Common.

Planning: No Planning applications had been received.

Finance: Precept. The Precept for 2015/16 had to be submitted to HC before the end of December so next
14/67 year's budget and the level of precept would be discussed and finalised at the December meeting.
