Minutes of the previous meeting hold on 9th February were agreed.

Leon read out a summary of the aim of the Neighbourhood Plan. There are 88 existing houses in Eaton Bishop (village envelope), and 18% more are planned by 2031. There are 26 houses in Ruckhall. The aim is to get the N.D.P. in before 'developers try to grab land'.

Further, it was mentioned that Breinton's draft document is massive with certain issues, which we do not have, so our document should be smaller and simpler. Mention was also made of an 'affordable housing document from the County Council' which we should look at. There was also mention of a "wedge of ground" belonging to Hereford Housing beside the playing field.

The draft of the flyer announcing the N.P. Open Day at the Village Hall on 7th March was passed around for perusal, and considered to be perfect as an invitation to all parishioners. It would be delivered to all households.
