Minutes of the Meeting of Blawith and Subberthwaite Parish Council held in the Water Yeat Village Hall on Monday 11th April, 2016.

Present: Councillors Ian Jones (Chair), Richard Sanderson (Vice Chair) Eileen Bower, Diana Rutherford, and Bill Fox; County Cllr David Fletcher; District Cllr Anne Hall; PCSO Paul Harris; the Clerk; Duncan Peake of Holker Estates and 4 members of the public.

1) Apologies for Absence

None

2)Representations from Members of the Public

2.a. PCSO Paul Harris reported there had been 2 calls for service – sheep at Lake Bank and the post box at Blawith broken into.

He will send further data from the SID when he has it. The data for the direction Coniston to Greenodd, located near to the church at Blawith recorded a 85th percentile speed of 42MH. The highest was 70MPH. Cllr Bower thanked PCSO Harris for his prompt attention.

Cllr Hall asked whether the police could bring any pressure regarding The Old Vicarage. She has written and informed the County Cllr to try and bring pressure on for a sharp bend sign. PCSO Harris advised that this wasn't something the police could assist with.

Cllr Jones reminded the meeting that CCC did do a risk assessment and removed the chevrons on the bend and put posts in. A 40 MPH limit would potentially help the problem.

2.b. Duncan Peake of Holker Estates gave a short presentation on the proposed extension of

Kirkby quarry and then answered questions from the Council and from members of the public. A resident of Chapels was especially concerned re potential flooding. Apparently the watercourse into Chapels is sometimes white. The deadline for submitting a response is 6th May. The Clerk had requested an extension until after the next meeting but hadn't had a reply. Resolved: To ask again for extension until 10th May and for PC response to be agreed at the meeting on 9th May. Particular issues relating to the development that the PC are looking at are ecological, flooding & roads.

- 2.c. Cllr Hall was there to give contributions to items on the agenda as they arose.
- 2.d. Cllr Fletcher advised that CCC are still dealing with the aftermath of the flooding and as a result other work has halted. Cllr Jones thanked Cllr Fletcher for his intervention regarding the U5081. Cllr Jones advised that the A5092 is badly deteriorating. Cllr Fletcher said he will take that up with CCC.

Cllrs discussed the inadequate infrastructure on the roads up to the West Coast in light of the developments at Moorside etc.

Cllr Fletcher advised that improvements in drainage should be seen as CCC are taking this back in house.

Cllr Fletcher gave an update on Broadband – phase 1 completes at the end of April. Phase 2 is for £6.5 million and negotiations are taking place as to the areas to be included. He advises lobbying to have B&S included in phase 2.

Cllr Rutherford advise that the footpath between Great Knott Farm & Blawith has vanished and is dangerous. This is tarmac underneath. Cllr Fletcher will look into this as it will be the responsibility of CCC as it is on the side of the Highway.
