

**Notice of the making of a Definitive Map Modification Order, North Yorkshire County Council, Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981, Restricted Byway no 15.70/55, Bagwith Road, Kirkby Malzeard, Modification Order 2019** The above Order, made on 15/01/19, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by upgrading the existing footpath to Restricted Byway between Bagwith House at GR 41970 47449 and GR 42011 47369 and adding a new section of Restricted Byway from GR 42011 47309 to GR 42037 47360 on the Kirkby Moor Road. A copy of the order as made and the Order Map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Ripon Library, North Yorkshire until 21/02/2019. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to "Ron Allan, Definitive Map Officer, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD", no later than 21/02/19 stating the grounds on which it is made. Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination. If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Yorkshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State or part of it if the Authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 may itself confirm the Order or that part of the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
