Parking Update

Some temporary measures are being put in place to help visitors to find out where they can park. All visitors parking bays on all phases have been, or will be, marked with a blue sign on the ground indicating that this is where they can park. Signs will be put up on the entrances to all phases to explain that there are marked visitor parking bays. A letter will be sent to all residents to communicate what has been done and to encourage residents to get their visitors to park in the correct bays. This is an interim solution and ongoing discussions are taking place to decide on the permanent solution.

Expect to see these signs over the next month.
