

#### "I wanna be leader"

At the time of writing, we are in the midst of a general election campaign with a few weeks left to run. They say that religion and politics don't mix and certainly Alastair Campbell didn't think so when he interrupted Tony Blair talking about his faith saying 'We don't do God'. But I must say that I don't think there's anything that doesn't mix with religion, or an understanding of the way that belief and faith shape people's lives. Politics that doesn't engage with this fundamental element of what it is to be human, is politics that is only superficial. In today's multi-faith Britain, we will need our politicians to be willing to engage with the questions and concerns of faith communities of all varieties and to help discover that there is more that unites us than divides us.

As we honour the right to cast our vote on 8<sup>th</sup> June, and choose a party to lead our country there will be many issues, pledges and promises to consider. The personality and leadership style of our politicians seems to become increasingly prominent. Among the many counter-cultural things that attracts me to Christianity is the style of leadership that Jesus demonstrates. He not only led by example, but his leadership came in the form of serving others:

"Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, <sup>27</sup> and whoever wants to be first must be your slave— <sup>28</sup> just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

We talk about 'serving' a term of office, but I wonder what we really mean by 'serving' in this context? In many contexts the word 'serve' has a sense of enabling, assisting and putting the needs of others before your own.

A life lived 'in service' may sound restricted, but a life spent truly engaging with the joys, struggles and pain of others can lead us into adventures, situations and a growing wisdom we would never have dreamed of. Even the most ordinary life spent in the service of others can be spectacular. On 8<sup>th</sup> June I think I might like to vote for the candidate who says this......

I wanna be the leader I wanna be the leader Can I be the leader? Can I? I can? Promise? Promise? Yippee I'm the leader I'm the leader





#### Report of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 8 May 2017

The Annual Parish Meeting was well attended by residents. Cllr Sarah Barker, Chair of the Kent Association of Local Councils, presented the KALC Community Award to Graham Cuthbert for his huge contribution to the local community over many years. Graham has played a diverse range of roles and is a long serving Parish Councillor, standing down as Chairman recently after ten accomplished years. He also sits on the Village Hall Committee and he was a Governor at Doddington School. Graham regularly helps with fund raising events and, assisted by his wife Liz, Graham hosts the annual Fireworks Display at Palace Farm which raises significant funds for the upkeep of the Village Hall.

Graham is a lifelong resident of Doddington; starting as a farmer, now runs a local tourism business which brings visitors to the area and benefits other Village businesses like the pub, the butchers and the garage. Cllr Barker said that Graham encapsulated everything that is good about supporting Village life with his selfless commitment and hard work. He is passionate about keeping rural communities alive for young and old, and is a very worthy recipient of the Award.

#### Report of the Annual Parish Council Meeting held on 8 May 2017

Cllr Attwood was re-elected as Chairman and Cllr Haynes was re-elected as Vice Chairman.

#### **COMMUNITY WARDEN**

Dave Osborne, the Community Warden, reported an attempted theft of a wooden gate which was removed from the entrance to a field in Old Lenham Road opposite the allotments and was subsequently found further along the road. Sheds at the allotments in Old Lenham Road were broken into. A lawn mower, strimmer and other gardening tools were stolen. On the same evening/night, a garage in Dully Hill was broken into and a quantity of lead was stolen. All incidents have been reported to Kent Police.

Mr Osborne asked for everyone to be vigilant for any suspicious activity in the village and to report any concerns to Kent Police on 101

#### WAR MEMORIAL



#### **NEWNHAM PARISH COUNCIL**

Summary of matters discussed at the Annual Meeting of Newnham Parish Council on Thursday, 11th May 2017

**Present:** Cllrs. S. Gunner, C. Woods, S. Elworthy, D. Cozens, A. Dye, J. Crampton and Clerk L. Bareham. SBC Cllr C Prescott and 1 resident also present.

#### Chairman's Annual Report

The Chairman reported that the weekly youth club had folded due to KCC allocating the contract to a different company. The new group only supplies training to volunteers and does not provide the staff, as previously. A taster session had been held at the Sharsted Cricket Club and some parents had come forward as volunteers. As yet, nothing further has been heard from Brogdale CIC with respect to their training.

The Community Bus Club had been running down due to lack of passengers. The bus was no longer full on its weekly trips to Faversham. It was becoming uneconomical to pay for a bus that benefited so few in the village. A decision had been made to review the service at the end of May. Other options such as a car share scheme will be considered during the forthcoming year.

The idea of providing some outdoor gym equipment, which could be used by all residents will also be pursued.

Village Hall - Clirs Gunner and Elworthy met with the chair and secretary of the Newnham Village Hall Committee who will be advertising for new trustees and will contact ARCK for advice and assistance. The hall lights were being changed to LEDs and quotes had been received. The electrician would also be asked to quote for the installation of the defibrillator.

Noxious smells - Concern was raised regarding the regular burning of horse manure in Seed Road and it was noted that there was plastics being burnt at Straight Hill. A resident had contacted the clerk regarding the smell in Frith Road, she had contacted the EA and asked if the parish council would do the same. It was noted that the smell was no longer present, but it was felt that there was little the EA could do when it returned.

Planning - Councillors could see no reason for objection to the outbuilding application at Foxenden Manor.





#### JUNE HISTORY NOTES

This month Newnham's Summer Fete takes place. There is a long history of summer fairs in Newnham. John de Campania (Champayne, Champion), a knight, was present in July 1300 when King Edward the First besieged Caerlaverock in the wars of Scottish Independence. Two years afterwards he was granted a Weekly Market on a Thursday, and an Annual Fair on June 29th, the feast of St Peter and Paul, at his Manor Champion Court. Edward flasted in his flistorical and Topographical account of Kent in 1798 described the fair as linen and pedlary, which means the business of pedlars, small wares for sale.
