



Dursley Walking Festival 2018 Treasure Hunt

Follow the route on the map in a clockwise direction. If you look near where the photos were taken you should be able to find the answer to the question. Some are easy to spot but others you will need to hunt around for.

The Route

From the Sainsbury's/Pulse car park exit, turn left along Castle Street. Turn left down Long Street.

Just past the Chantry Centre, turn right down a footpath. At the end, continue left onto Water Street.

Turn right at the bottom, then left onto Brownings Lane. Continue straight along the footpath.

At the end of the path head diagonally to the right and walk along Ferney. Cross at the pedestrian crossing, turn right then take the alleyway on the left.

Turn left along Rosebery Road, then look for a narrow path to the right.

At the top of the path you can wander around the church yard. Leave by the front gate and turn right.

Take the next left up Fort Lane then the path up to the right. Continue along Upper Poole Rd going straight on at the roundabout. Turn right down Boulton Lane then left at the bottom.

Go straight on onto Parsonage Street then turn right by Barclay's Bank to return to the start.
