Damage/Vandalism related incidents reported in January 2019: 4 reported crimes, enquiries ongoing

ASB related incidents reported in January 2019: 2 incidents reported, 0 crimes

- Cycle path behind Tesco – youths loitering
- Costa Coffee – Youths intimidating staff

Officers have been along the cycle path on a number of occasions and into the area it is suspected the youths loiter and gather. No youths seen at the time. Patrols will continue.

PC Martin Crow has had a meeting with staff at Costa Coffee regarding youths as issues are becoming a regular occurrence. Officers to attend Costa regularly.
