HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (STONELEIGH JUNCTION) (SLIP ROADS) ORDER 2018

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice of a proposal to make an Order under Sections 10 and 41 of the Highway Act 1980 authorising the construction of two new slip roads to connect the A46 Trunk Road to the improved Stoneleigh Road being constructed by Warwickshire County Council.

Copies of the draft Order and the plan referred to in it may be inspected free of charge, at all reasonable hours, at Warwickshire County Council Shire Hall, Warwick CV34 4RL and at Kenilworth Library and One Stop Shop, Smalley Place, Kenilworth, CV8 1QG from 20 July 2018 to 5 September 2018. They may also be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below.

ANY PERSON MAY OBJECT to the making of the Order within six weeks from the date of first publication of this notice, to the Secretary of State for Transport, National Transport Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle Business Park, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7AR or nationalcasework@dft.gov.uk, quoting "A46 Trunk Road Stoneleigh Junction (Slip Roads) Order" and stating the grounds of objection.

In submitting an objection it should be noted that your personal data and correspondence will be passed to Warwickshire County Council as the Promoting Authority for the scheme to enable your objection to be considered. Where the Order becomes the subject of Public Inquiry Procedures, all correspondence is copied to the Inspector conducting the Inquiry and will be kept in the PI library, where it is publicly available. If you do not wish your personal data to be forwarded, please state your reasons when submitting your objection and the Secretary of State will copy your representations, with your name and address removed, to the Council and if there is to be a Public Local Inquiry they will be seen by the Inspector who may give them less weight as a result.
