

A429 works: one night closure and lane closure

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High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Please note: the timeframes and dates in this notification may be subject to change at short notice

Traffic management for our work in Crackley

LM will close a small section of the A429 Coventry Road/Kenilworth Road for one night to safely create a new access point off the A429 into our work site in Crackley. At this location, we are building a temporary road (known as a 'haul road') for future construction traffic.

After this temporary road closure, an ongoing 24/7 lane closure will be put in place on the northbound side of the road, featuring temporary two-way traffic lights. This will help us ensure the safety of everyone using the road while we work at the edge of the A429.

The following pages contain maps indicating the location of upcoming traffic management, plus information on future work.

Safety for pedestrians and cyclists

We will put a walkway in place to maintain access through the closure for pedestrians. The cycle path will be closed during the overnight road closure and subsequent lane closure, with a diversion in place.

Cyclists can dismount to walk through the closure, or they can divert off the A429 cycle path onto National Cycle Route 52 (off Coventry Road) and at Cryfield Grange Road. Signs will be in place to show the cycling diversion route.

Temporary road closure from **8.00pm on 25 March until 6.00am on 26 March**, followed by single lane closure in place 24/7 from 26 March for up to two months.

Our working hours

Some noise from machinery during our working hours, and potential traffic delays during peak times.

Future work on the A429 Coventry Road/Kenilworth Road

After we've finished our work on the northbound lane, the temporary lane closure will switch to the southbound side of the road at the same location. This will create a safe working zone for our work to widen the A429. The A429 needs to be widened to accommodate construction traffic getting in and out of the haul road, which ultimately helps HS2 keep lorries off local roads.
