Zion Chapel was said to have been founded in 1802 (not 1800) which appears in manuals & handbooks as an initial mistake by JOSEPH LACON (listed) in his Handbook of 1873 (Source: PGS Hopwood)

FOOTNOTES

- (from Ancestry): son of JOHN LACON & MARY WHITRIDGE of Oswestry - 1 of 8 children (6 daughters & 2 sons ?) - brother was JOSEPH LACON. Mary Whitridge's family were Congregationalists (there were Ministers in the family) - no mention of JOHN'S presence in Sheffield (he married MARY OLDKNOW)
 - JOSEPH WATTS - famous for chemist shop Attercliffe - active at Zion Chapel in 1870s

- February 1948, Historical draft by Dr G S Hopwood: "Gates of Zion" - the story of a church. Author, Auberon E B... (Zion organist for 52 years). MS shown as property of A E Ward, 22 Bramley Park Road, S9.
 - Atterclevean folk (people of Attercliffe).
 - Goose Green was lost in 1811 as a result of the Enclosures Act.
 - Old Hall occupied by the Spencers.
 - Thomas Hancock mentioned.
 - Lack of a Church at Attercliffe, so Matthew Bloome of Attercliffe and Thomas Hancock of Shirecliffe started the Zion Church "midway betwixt". People found Shirecliffe too far to travel for worship.
 - First Zion congregation was 25 including Spencer of Attercliffe Hall.
 - Bloome died in 1686. Hancock died in 1685.
 - OAKES - go back 300 years to the Attercliffe tailor Matthew Oakes (born 1625) - 5 sons went into cutlery (3 into scissors).
 - JOHN WHITRIDGE LACON was the son of JOSEPH LACON who worked for JOSEPH READ's Sheffield Smelting Company (now THESSCO) then became manager of new Birmingham branch.
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
