St Egwin was an English nobleman who became bishop of Worcester in AD 692. Charged with being overly strict by his clergy, Egwin went to Rome. Upon his return to England, and prompted by a vision of Our Blessed Lady, he founded Evesham Abbey with the aid of Coenred, King of Mercia. In AD 709, Egwin returned to Rome, accompanied by King Coenred and King Offa of the East Saxons. (To learn more about this local saint see the short article in Early British Kingdoms.)


3:00 p.m. on Sunday 14 January 2nd Sunday after Epiphany
