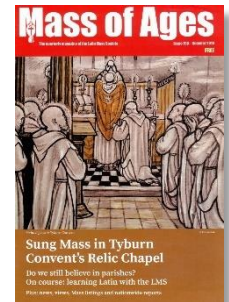

Kevin is based at St George's in Worcester but also attends our Masses at St Wulstan's with his wife, Anne.



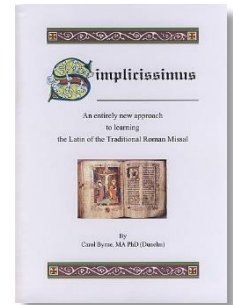
Organ Recital – St Wulstan’s, 12:00 noon on Saturday 7 July

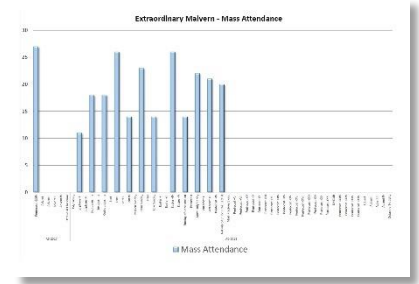


Sunday 11 November AD 2018 – Remembrance Sunday

It is proposed that the Mass on the Centenary of the Armistice be a Sung Requiem Mass for the Fallen and preparations are already under way. It will be good to be offering a Requiem Mass in what is now called the *Extraordinary Form*, but which would have been entirely familiar to Catholics of all sides at the time of both World Wars.
