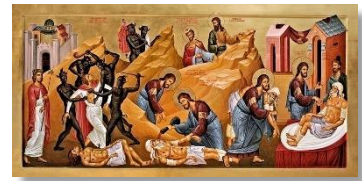

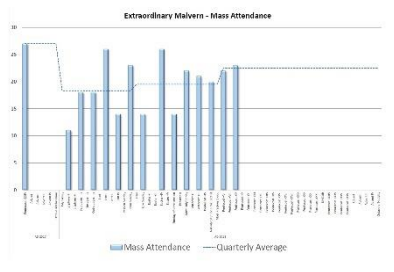
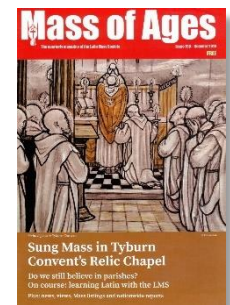
Sunday 11 November AD 2018 – Remembrance Sunday
