3:00 p.m. on Sunday 11 November Requiem Mass for the Fallen

Mass on the Centenary of the Armistice will be a Sung Requiem Mass for the Fallen and preparations are already well under way: the parish catafalque and funeral pall have been unearthed; I hope to be able to clean and restore the six wrought iron funeral candle stands for the catafalque; and a set of antique black vestments has been acquired.





The Requiem Mass will be offered in what is now called the *Extraordinary Form*, but which would have been entirely familiar to Catholics of all sides at the time of both World Wars.

The celebrant will be **Dom Jonathan Rollinson OSB**. Mass will be sung by <u>Schola Gregoriana Malverniensis</u> with the *Kyrie*, *Sanctus*, and *Agnus Dei* from Victoria's *Missa pro defunctis a 4*.

LMS Pilgrimage to Wrexham – Sat 13 October AD 2018

This annual pilgrimage, in association with the **Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest**, will take place at St Mary's Cathedral, Wrexham. It will comprise a *Missa Cantata* (Gregorian Chant) at 11.30am followed by veneration of the relic of Martyr and LMS co-patron, St Richard Gwyn.

A new look for the Schola




