Lower Slaughter Parish Council Buses and Coaches in Lower Slaughter

Please be advised that, in 1995, the County Council passed a Traffic Regulation order under the Traffic Regulation Act 1984. In the order, **buses and coaches (9 or more seats) are not permitted to enter the village unless -**

1. They are a local service bus (based within 15 miles of Lower Slaughter), or
2. They have entered the village to drop off or pick up at the hotels in the village (and only the hotels in the village).

Having dropped off at the hotels, they **MUST** immediately leave the village and only return to pick up the passengers later.

Bus parking in the village is illegal. Please pass this information on to the management of your company.

Vehicles whose drivers breach this local traffic order commit an offence when they drive into Lower Slaughter. This offence may be dealt with by way of a fixed penalty notice for the driver or via summons to court. There are signs instructing drivers of this restriction on all roads into the village from the A429.
