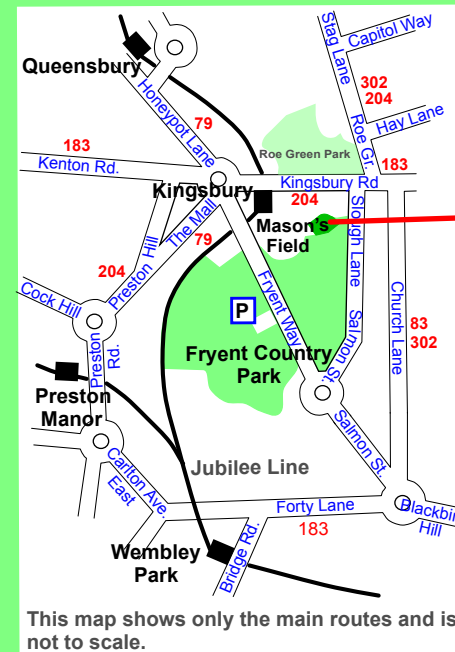
**On Sunday the 24th of November between 10 am and 12.30 we shall begin planting.....come and help !**

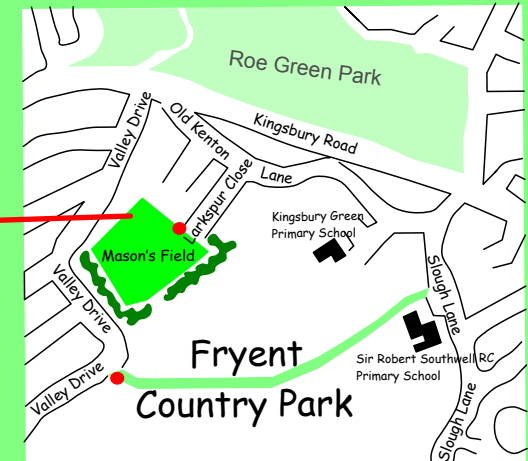

**Mason's Field was made a nature reserve in September of this year and the bulb planting is one of a number of improvements made to the field over the last few years. The intention is to create a wild flower meadow and integrate the space with the larger nature reserve of Fryent Country Park.**
